The pandemic temporarily restricted our opportunities for in-person worship together and significantly impacted many of Trinity's group activities and programs. Fortunately, our Church staff and many volunteers accepted the connectivity challenges presented by the pandemic and have been very creative in finding solutions. However, while all of these initiatives were necessary to achieve the mission of the Church, they also resulted in additional costs that will require your financial support.
