(CK). Both these organizations really need our help through the summer months to provide food to members of our community that deal with food insecurity on a daily basis.


# **Dates for Mission Thursday are as follows:**

Since the start of Mission Thursday during the early stages of the pandemic, we have donated over 26,000 sandwiches, almost 11,000 bottles of water, almost 900 bags of fruit and over 350 bags/boxes of snacks to CK. In addition, we have donated over 13,000 pounds of food and miscellaneous supplies to the CHFP. Through these donations, we are making a real difference in our community.
