However, while our new ways of connecting and serving God have progressed, they have also resulted in additional costs that

This is a friendly reminder that our stewardship Campaign continues and your pledge is critical to maintain Trinity's programs, mission and staff. At this point in the Campaign, we have achieved only 90% of our financial goal and have received 193 pledges against our goal of 225.


