
Sunday Summer Childcare Schedule

Mission Thursdays Continues Through The Summer

The Mission & Outreach Committee has decided to continue Mission Thursday through the summer. Many organizations take a "pause" through the summer so donations are down to both the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (CHFP) and Cathedral Kitchen (CK). Both these organizations really need our help





through the summer months to provide food to members of our community that deal with food insecurity on a daily basis.

August 11th and 25th

The Mission & Outreach Committee wants to thank the congregation for their outstanding support of the CHFP and CK. Since the start of Mission Thursday during the early stages of the pandemic, we have donated over 26,000 sandwiches, almost 11,000 bottles of water, almost 900 bags of fruit and over 350 bags/boxes of snacks to CK. In addition, we have donated over 13,000 pounds of food and miscellaneous supplies to the CHFP. Through these donations, we are making a real difference in our community.
