TRINITY CHURCH SCHOOL

Our Church School program for children age $2\frac{1}{2}$ through Grade 6 continues in January. Our new rotation program launched in November, and has generated excitement from both children and parents. Here is the schedule of events for January.

January 2, 2022: Mission Sunday – Grade school-age children will meet for a joint lesson and activity in Witherspoon. They will be taught a Bible lesson that will focus on Jesus's call to serve those in need. Afterward, the children will help assemble personal care packages, to be mailed and distributed by the Presbyterian Disaster Relief Assistance, which help those who have faced disasters both in the US and abroad.





January 9, 2022: Family Church – Rev. Sarah will lead families in worship in the Community Room in a relaxed, casual atmosphere that will allow families to grow their faith together. *Children of all ages are welcome!* Come to the Community Room by 9:30am; parents / guardians should plan on staying with your child(ren) for the service.

January 16, 2022: Church School – All children will participate in a traditional church school lesson in their respective classrooms.

January 23, 2022: Let's Worship Together – Grade school children will attend worship in the sanctuary with their parents.

January 30, 2022: Church School – All children will participate in a traditional church school lesson in their respective classrooms.


Fellowship Group

Facebook– Our Facebook site will also keep you informed. This is also where you can post comments and share photos!


YouTube Videos— Check out our Virtual Worship videos but also videos of past musical performances and congregants sharing what makes Trinity such a great place to worship!
