

## Camp Johnsonburg Campaign



My name is Katie Carboni, I am a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church, in Cherry Hill, NJ. I have been a member of the church my whole life, and have been going to Presbyterian summer camps since I was seven.

My faith has been shaped under the trees, learning that "creation would be a reflection of God and a connection to God." (The Green Bible, 2008) Outdoor ministry has been one of the main cornerstones of my faith journey. From acting out Bible stories at the outdoor chapel, sitting around a campfire reflecting on my faith with others, to silently walking the labyrinth praying to my Creator. I would not be the person I am today without outdoor ministry. Camp wasn't just swimming in the lake, or roasting marshmallows, or singing the Revolution at Wednesday lunch - as those are still all wonderful things; it taught me skills that are necessary for life.



Knowing that God has walked with me through these years of camp faith building, I hope I can keep the spark of outdoor ministry alive for the next generation of children.

## High School Graduates




**Cara Mailahn** will be attending Rowan University majoring in Health and Physical Education.
