Baptismal Joy

As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

Galatians 3:27

This month is a month of joy for our congregation because we will participate in the baptism of four children and also welcome seven young people into full membership. The Apostle Paul tells us that when we were baptized—when we were brought through the waters and the Triune Name was applied to us—we "put on Christ." Paul is telling us that in our baptism we have now been so intimately joined to Christ, that the Lord Jesus himself covers us. Christ covers us with his faithfulness and mercy.

The children that will be baptized this month will be joined to Christ, and in their baptism, Christ will promise to be with them in this life and in eternity. During Commissioning Sunday, our seven commissioners, eighth graders who have completed two years of preparation in order to make their public confirmation of faith, will affirm their baptismal vowels. What was said on their behalf when they were infants, will now be said by them as they enter into a fuller realization of what it means to be clothed with Christ.

Sometimes we say that baptism is the doorway into the church, but Saint Paul says that Baptism is the sacrament by which we are not only covered with water, but that the water of baptism is an outward sign of an inward reality: that in Christ we mystically, and spiritually and truly and really have been covered with God's love. Now the truth is, wherever we are, wherever we go, God surrounds us with his invisible, but no less powerful, love. That is the joy of our baptism. That is the joy of being a Christian!

In this month of baptismal joy, I hope each of us will spend some time reflecting on what it means to be the baptized children of God—those who have "put on Christ." May God bless the babies that will be baptized! May God bless our young sisters and brothers as they confirm their baptismal vow to follow Jesus as Lord. And may the God of our baptisms help *each of us* to reflect more thoroughly on the reality of the saving relationship which we have been given in our Risen Lord. Sisters and brothers, if you and I will do that, we will have great reason to spend this Eastertide,
