We will be open Tuesdays & Thursdays & the "first Saturday" of the month (October 2) from 10 am to 1 pm.


We will accept donations during our regular hours and on Sundays following 9:30 worship service. Please do not leave any items if there is no one there to accept them. Do not leave outside!


CROP WALK 2021!

With a new program year underway, we've resumed the in-church practice of passing the Membership Registers to record our attendance at church. But what if you're watching at home?




