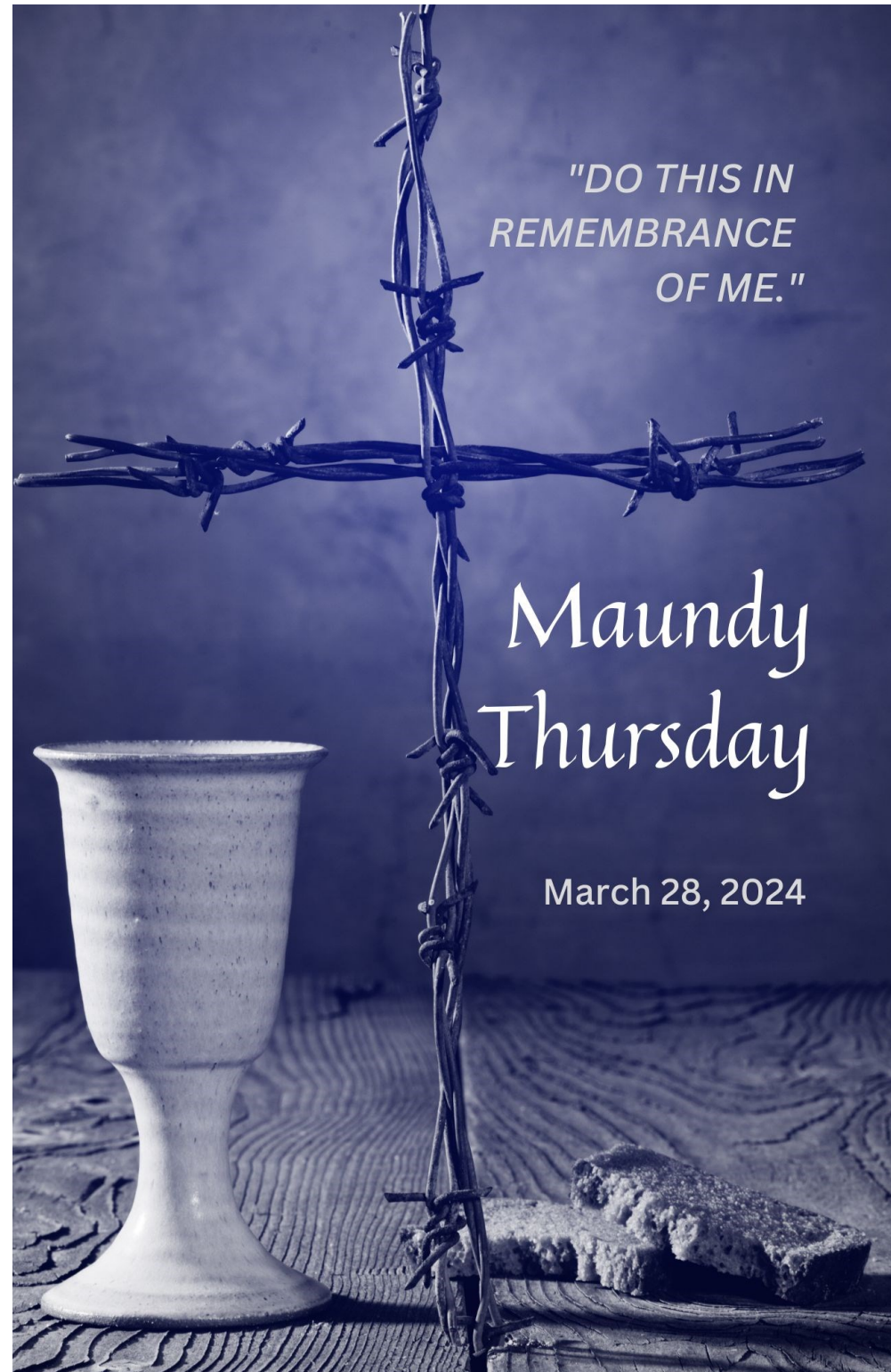

MAUNDY THURSDAY TENEBRAE COMMUNION
March 28, 2024 – 7:30 pm

This service is a version of the ancient office of Tenebrae sung during Holy Week. Tenebrae is the Latin word which means shadows or darkness. In the service, worshippers are given the opportunity to meditate on the darkness of the last days of Jesus, through Scripture, prayer, silence, hymns, and the gradual extinguishing of candles. Tonight's Tenebrae also incorporates the commemoration of the Institution of the Lord's Supper that is associated with Maundy Thursday.

The congregation will remain seated throughout the service. All worshippers are asked to leave in silence following the Benediction. Please remember to sign the fellowship register, located in the pew.
